I have, therefore, to inform you that if you do not see that your daughter attends school regularly the Department will be compelled to take action under the Regulations Relating to the Education of Indian Children to have her committed to a residential school. You yourself are liable to fine or imprisonment if you neglect, after receiving this notice, to see that she attends each day it is open and that she remains there during the regular school hours.

and that there will be no need to take action as mentioned above and that you will see that your daughter attends school regularly each day in future.
