PARATROOPS WERE DROPPED FROM 39 JU52'S ON RACCHI RIDGE IN THE CENTRE OF

3/4 MI. WIDE NECK JOINING N. AND S. PORTIONS OF ISLAND. ENEMY HELD RIDGE

BUT ARE UNDER FIRE FROM RIGH GROUND. LANDINGS SUPPORTED BY DIVE BONBING

IN N. OF ISLAND ENEMY HAS MADE SLIGHT ADVANCES INLAND. IN CENTRE PARATROOPS HAVE BEEN REINFORCED BY LANDING GURNA BAY AND ENEMY NOW CONTROLS OF ALL/THE NECK BETVERN GURNA AND ALINDA BAYS. ENEMY CAPTURED APPETICE ABOUT 1200 HOURS. BY MIDWIGHT 12 HOVEMBER ESTIMATED 2000 MEN AND 500 PARATROOPS LANDED. BONBING HEAVY.
