The accused, B 134823 Private James Henry KEETING, Hastings & Prince Edward Regiment, on the strength of No 10 Canadian Repatriation Depot, a soldier of the Canadian Army Overseas, is charged with:

FIRST CHARGE WHILE ON ACTIVE SERVICE, Absenting himself without leave,

Section 15(1)

in that he,

In the Field, at No 10 Canadian Repatriation Depot, absented himself without leave from 0800 hours 9 December 1945 until apprehended by the Canadian Provost Corps at London at 0100 hours on 8 January 1946. Total absence 29 days, 17 hours.

SECOND CHARGE

WHILE ON ACTIVE SERVICE, Conduct to the Prejudice of Good Order and Military Discipline,

Section 40
Army Act

in that he,

In the Field, at London on 8 January 1946 made use of a document purporting to be a genuine pass wall knowing that it was not genuine.
