- Q. How much land have you got where you are?
- A. I cannot tell you because I don't understand how much an acre is.
- Q. Are there any white people living around you?
- A. There is lots of stakes around me, but no one lives there.
- Q. Does anyone live around where Cahoose lives?
- A. He is just the same as I am.
- Q. Has anyone ever staked the land that you are occupying?
- A. I don't know.
- Q. How many people live at your place?
- A. Just four - two girls and my wife and me.
- Q. How many live at Cahoose's place?
- A. About twelve.
- Q. Who are they?
- A. Cahoose, his wife and his children.
- Q. No one else?
- A. No.
- Q. How many children has Cahoose?
- A. I believe he has ten children and his father and mother.
- Q. Have you buildings on the land that you occupy?
- A. Oh yes - I have a house, stables, cattle sheds and fences.
- Q. How much fencing would you have?
- A. About two or three miles.
- Q. How many horses have you?
- A. One hundred and thirty horses.
- Q. How many cattle?
- A. I have no cattle - I sold them all.
- Q. Do you plow land there?
- A. No - it is just a meadow.
- Q. And you cut hay there for your stock?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Have you any farming implements?
- A. I have a mowing machine, rakes, waggons and two sleighs.
- Q. Have you hay enough to feed your horses during the winter?
- A. Yes.
