

# OUR CARD SYSTEM FOR THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LIBRARIAN

## SIMPLEST, HANDIEST, CHEAPEST

Our NEW LIBRARIAN'S CARD, offers the simplest, and at the same time most effective method of keeping track of books lent. It does away with the need of bulky Records, as it contains, in itself, all necessary information.

On the face side it has a blank date for each Sunday in the year. On the reverse side a list of numbers from 1 to 400.

One card is used for each person who borrows books from the Library, the name and Class number being filled in, in the space provided for that purpose.

The method of using is simplicity itself:—When a book is given out,

- (1) An X is marked opposite the date when it is given out.
- (2) A line is drawn through the number on the back of the card, corresponding to the number of the book given out.
- (3) The Card is put in place of book on shelf till the book is returned.

In this way, with the minimum of labor, an absolutely complete record is kept of books read and the various dates at which they have been lent.
