

Governor to pay out of the Province Treasury to the Coroners of the different Counties for every Inquest 30s. each.

time being to pay out of the Treasury of the Province to the Coroners of the different Counties, the Sum of Thirty Shillings for every inquest taken on any Dead Body and properly returned to the Clerk of the Crown, such Sum to be applied by the Coroner to the Interment of such Dead Body, and any further Charge attending such Inquest shall be paid by the County in which the same shall be taken.

Governor to appoint a Person as a Waiter and Guager in each of the Out Ports, to be allowed five per Cent. on Net Revenue Collected.

XII. *And be it further enacted,* That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, to appoint a fit and proper Person as a Waiter and Guager in each of the Out Ports and Districts of this Province, who shall be paid Five Pounds for every Hundred Pounds of Net Revenue collected in such Port or District and paid into the Treasury.
