AUTO RIDE ENDS IN MURDER TRAGEDY

Mysterious Disappearance of German Speculator While Guest of Alabama Matron

Husband of Woman Claims Alibi, But is Held as Witness Against Chauffeur

Montgomery, Ala., Aug. 8.—With the release today of I. E. Boyette, after a preliminary hearing on the charge that he shot P. J. Westhofen, a young German adventurer, much speculation is attached to the circumstances surrounding Westhofen's death.

Authorities are inclined to disregard the statement of Isaac White, a chauffeur, that he saw Westhofen, when in company with Mrs. Boyette, shoot himself through the arm, and White is held to await action of the grand jury.

Westhofen died Monday of lockjaw caused by the wound in the arm.

The shooting took place in a stretch of woods eight miles from Montgomery, whether the young German, with Mrs. Boyette, who is the daughter of Richard Tills, Montgomery millionaire, were driven by White.

Mrs. Boyette's young son was in the party.

Started a Thrill

The incident aroused a sensation from the start. The portion of the evidence for trial on a charge of negligence in not calling medical attention to his daughter, who subsequently died. The girl suffered untold agony from burns and lacerations, and medical aid only being called just shortly before her death.

THE BRITISH TRUCK FARMERS IN ONTARIO ARE DISSATISFIED

Land Company Failed to Fulfill Promises Made to Settlers Regarding Market

Farmers Cannot Sell Fruit or Vegetables, Although They Have Railway Facilities

Chatham, Ont., Aug. 8.—According to reports that have reached this city, the discontent exists among British farmers settled upon the intensively farmed lands in Tilbury last spring.

The settlers claim that promises of the land company that a co-operative organization would be formed for handling vegetables and fruit have been unfulfilled, and that though they have railway facilities for shipping there is no available market for their produce.

As a result they have been compelled to sell to farmers at low prices.

Some farmers threaten to return to England this fall. Litigation is talked of, while others have decided to go west.

WOUND METAL THREAD ABOUT HEART VEIN

A Remarkable Operation for Aortic Aneurism in New York Hospital

Wire Will Act as Sort of Artificial Wall for the Large Artery

New York, Aug. 8.—A remarkable operation for aortic aneurism, the second of its kind attempted in the city, was performed in Bellevue hospital by Dr. William C. Lusk.

Thirty-six feet of gold wire were wrapped around the aorta, the heart vein, and the vent of electricity sent through the wire which reduced the swelling of the artery sufficiently to allow it to perform its natural functions through artificial means. The operation took place in the Crane room, and was witnessed by the medical faculty of Bellevue and about 50 of the leading surgeons of New York.
