THE HARBOUR IMPROVEMENT.

The adjourned debate on this subject came up to day in the Assembly. A week has almost elapsed since the last discussion afforded the members a little breathing time before they enter again into the series of operations of implicating our future revenue in a project that may end in the total bankruptcy of the colony. There is not, we believe, a single person in the country who is opposed to the improvement of Victoria Harbour, but the best of things can be purchased too dearly. There are many obstacles in the Island—both physical and political—that require removal; but no one will contend for a moment that the colony is in a position at the present time to involve itself in an outlay of hundreds of thousands of dollars for such works. We would like to see the country interested with railway from east to the west, but we are afraid we shall wait for the wagon before we venture upon such gigantic undertakings. We would rejoice at the "making" of Victoria harbour—the removal of every rock, pebble, and sand that might obstruct navigation, the closer, financial support by the principal bankers here agreed to, offered by the purchasers of national property.
