BOOM IN NEW YORK STOCKS.

THE CHICAGO MARKET ALSO STRONG AT THE CLOSE. Increased Activity on the Local Stock Exchange. Advances to Riebelien-Moderate Trade in Local Wheat—Good Demand for Choice Butchers' Cuts—Cotton and Oil Firm.

Canadian Pacific received 34 letters in London, at 7:30. Consols higher, closing today at 89 1/2 for money and account.

Money on call in London is firmer at 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 per cent. Silver easier at 25 1/2 in London and at 79 1/2 at New York.

Earnings of Canadian Pacific the third week of November were \$467,000, an increase of \$3000 as compared with the corresponding week of last year.

The amount of gold in the United States Treasury is \$84,668,000.
