Note. The Plags are in such request that they can only be loaned for about ten days, so, in order to avoid disappointment, it would be well to send the date for which they will be required, to Room 20, as soon as it is decided upon.

ORDER IN ADVANCE. Letters are frequently received or-dering leaflets by return mail.
