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KEY TO PRONUNCIATION.

Sound G as in Get before e & i; and as in Gall before a, o, & u. Ḡ is produced by touching soft palate with base of tongue, (teeth 1 inch apart,) while exploding vowel. E as C in Call before a, o, & u; and like K in Key before e & i. To sound K hold tip of tongue against bottom teeth, leaving thin space between surface and palate, then moderately expel the breath. c.f., ch in Ich, Ger. K is a guttural aspirate, and is produced by so expelling the breath as to cause vibration of Uvula. L̄ is sounded by holding tip tongue against hard palate, as in sounding cl in Clay, and then forcibly expel the breath over, and out at each side of the tongue. c. f., ll, Welsh. QU is sharply whispered off at the end of a word. The Hiatus (') denotes a short catch of the breath as in the words Go' over. N. B. For the present any accented vowel in *pica type* must be read as *long*.
