

Furthermore, comparing the percentage of total budget which Canadians believe is spent with what they believe should be spent confirms that there is some sensitivity to spending levels currently in place. That is, a greater proportion believe that spending should constitute no more than 1% of the total budget than believe it currently does, and fewer believe that the budget allotted to foreign aid should exceed 10% than believe it currently does.
