

TEXT OF THE BRITISH PRESS RELEASE

ISSUED MARCH 8, 1977

At the invitation of the Prime Minister, the Right Honourable James Callaghan, the Heads of States and Governments of Canada, France, Federal Republic of Germany, Italy, Japan and the United States will meet at 10 Downing Street on May 7-8, 1977.

The aim of the meeting, which will be only the third such summit to be held, is to enable the leaders of the world's main industrialized nations to discuss in depth problems facing both developed and developing countries.
