## AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION

FOR THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA, 1974
A new chapter XIV is added after chapter XIII, as follows:

## "CHAPTER XIV

## SAFETY MEASURES FOR SHIPS OPERATING IN POLAR WATERS

## Regulation 1 - Definitions

For the purpose of this chapter:
1 Polar Code means the International Code for Ships Operating in Polar Waters, consisting of an introduction and parts I-A and II-A and parts I-B and II-B, as adopted by resolutions MSC.385(94) and of the Marine Environment Protection Committee, as may be amended, provided that:
. 1 amendments to the safety-related provisions of the introduction and part I-A of the Polar Code are adopted, brought into force and take effect in accordance with the provisions of article VIII of the present Convention concerning the amendment procedures applicable to the annex other than chapter I; and
. 2 amendments to part I-B of the Polar Code are adopted by the Maritime Safety Committee in accordance with its Rules of Procedure.

2 Antarctic area means the sea area south of latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{S}$.
3 Arctic waters means those waters which are located north of a line from the latitude $58^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $042^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$ to latitude $64^{\circ} 37^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $035^{\circ} 27^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence by a rhumb line to latitude $67^{\circ} 03^{\prime} .9 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $026^{\circ} 33^{\prime} .4 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence by a rhumb line to the latitude $70^{\circ} 49^{\prime} .56 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $008^{\circ} 59^{\prime} .61 \mathrm{~W}$ (Sørkapp, Jan Mayen) and by the southern shore of Jan Mayen to $73^{\circ} 31^{\prime} .6 \mathrm{~N}$ and $019^{\circ} 01^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{E}$ by the Island of Bjørnøya, and thence by a great circle line to the latitude $68^{\circ} 38^{\prime} .29 \mathrm{~N}$ and longitude $043^{\circ} 23^{\prime} .08 \mathrm{E}$ (Cap Kanin Nos) and hence by the northern shore of the Asian Continent eastward to the Bering Strait and thence from the Bering Strait westward to latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$ as far as Il'pyrskiy and following the 60th North parallel eastward as far as and including Etolin Strait and thence by the northern shore of the North American continent as far south as latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$ and thence eastward along parallel of latitude $60^{\circ} \mathrm{N}$, to longitude $056^{\circ} 37^{\prime} .1 \mathrm{~W}$ and thence to the latitude $58^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~N}$, longitude $042^{\circ} 00^{\prime} .0 \mathrm{~W}$.
