DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Honourable Allan J. MacEachen, Deputy Prime Minister and Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Mr. William Thomas Delworth (54), born in Toronto, Ontario, as Ambassador to Sweden.

Mr. Delworth (B.A., University of Toronto, 1951; M.A., University of Toronto, 1956) joined the Department of External Affairs in 1956. He has served abroad in Stockholm and as Senior Political Advisor in Indochina with the International Control and Supervision Commission. In 1970, Mr. Delworth was named Ambassador to Indonesia and in 1974 was named Ambassador and Head of Delegation to the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe. Mr. Delworth was named as the first resident Canadian Ambassador to Hungary in 1975 and he subsequently served concurrently as Ambassador and Head of Delegation to the Belgrade Follow-Up Meeting of the CSCE from 1977 to 1978. At Headquarters he has served as Assistant Under-Secretary for Asian and Pacific Affairs from 1978 to 1982 and from 1982 to 1983 was Assistant Deputy Minister for Political Affairs. Since September 1983, Mr. Delworth has been Special Advisor to the Deputy Minister - Foreign Policy. He will replace Mr. André Couvrette.
