ROYAL ASSENT

The Honourable Peter deC. Cory, Puisne Judge of the Supreme Court of Canada, in his capacity as Deputy Governor General, having come and being seated at the foot of the Throne, and the House of Commons having been summoned, and being come with their Deputy Speaker, the Honourable Deputy Governor General was pleased to give Royal Assent to the following bills:

An Act to correct certain anomalies, inconsistencies, archaisms and errors in the Statutes of Canada, to deal with other matters of non-controversial and uncomplicated nature therein and to repeal certain provisions thereof

that have expired or lapsed or otherwise ceased to have effect (Bill C-35, Chapter 1, 1992)

An Act to amend the Canada Pension Plan (Bill C-57, Chapter 2, 1992)

An Act to implement conventions between Canada and Finland, Canada and the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic and Canada and the United Mexican States for the avoidance of double taxation with respect to income tax and the prevention of fiscal evasion and a convention between Canada and the United Mexican States for the exchange of information with respect to taxes (Bill S-2, Chapter 3, 1992)

The sitting of the Senate was resumed.
