

shall deposit all monies of the Association, except the sum of Fifty Dollars, which he shall keep on hand to meet current expenses; pay all bills authorized by the Committee of Management and none other; and at the regular meetings in May, August and November, present a quarterly, and at the annual meeting a yearly return of the financial condition of the Association, including a statement of receipts and expenditures.

Sergeant-at-Arms.

Sec. 7.—The Sergeant-at-Arms shall punctually attend all meetings of the Association, answer to the names of Officers absent at the call of the roll; preserve order when called on by the presiding officer; attend the door and admit no persons save members of the Association, except by order from the chair.

ARTICLE VI.—STANDING COMMITTEES.

Standing Committees.
Summary of.

Sec. 1.—The Standing Committees of this Association shall be a Committee of Management, a Committee of Finance, an Investigating Committee, and such other committees as may be found necessary to take control of any property of the Association.

Sec. 2.—The Committee of Management shall consist of fifteen members, to be elected by ballot at the annual meeting, five of whom shall retire annually by rotation, but shall be eligible for re-election; and the officers of the Association, who shall be members (*ex officio*). The Committee shall decide upon all applications for membership in the manner prescribed by the Constitution, appoint an Investigating Committee and such other standing committees not provided for in the Constitution, as may be found necessary for the proper working of the Association; such standing committees to be appointed at the
