THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-25.

An Act for the relief of Margaret Catherine Smith.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Margaret Catherine Smith, residing at the city of St. Lambert, in the province of Quebec, wife of Douglas Kerr Smith, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the nineteenth day of June, A.D. 5 1948, at the said city, she then being Margaret Catherine Mann; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his failure to consummate the said marriage, their marriage be annulled; and whereas the said marriage and the said failure to consummate have been proved by 10 evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage annulled.

1. The said marriage is hereby annulled, and 15 shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
