Sergeant and 10 or 12 men ordered to mount guard during the nights at the Blockhouse, Dartmouth.....	23 Feb., 1751
Indians attacked Dartmouth, killing a number of the inhabitants .....	13 May, 1751
German emigrants arrived at Halifax, and were employed picketing the back of Dartmouth .....	.. July, 1751
Ferry established between Dartmouth and Halifax, John Conner, ferryman.	3 Feb., 1752
Mill at Dartmouth sold to Maj. Ezekiel Gilman .....	.. June, 1752
