Extract from Gen Order dated 30th Decr 1834
No 2. The Commander of the Forces has been
pleased, to make, the following changes
in the Garrison Orders of the Garrison of India
under the heading

Harm, Parts & turning out in Camp &c

This Duty is to be performed in
Relation, by the Regt or Regiments occupying
the several Barracks, and by the Royal
Artillery which is to be accounted as a
Regt. in taking their turn, & duty at times
Except in cases where a Government
Building, or a Building containing Gov-
ernment property, is actually on fire
or in danger of being set on fire, the
Regts are not required to render their
assistance as a matter of course. Assistance
however, will be afforded to the extent & in
the manner provided by the visiting
Garrison Orders, upon personal application
or in writing to the Commanding Officer of the Garrison.
