ANY person who is the sole head of a family; or any male over 18 years may homestead a quarter section of able Dominion land in Manitoba, Sas available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader hay live within hine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occapied by him or by his father, mothoccupied by him or by his father, macher, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good stancing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongsider his homestead. Price \$2.00 uer acre.
