HOG FATTENING RECORD CHADRON, Neb., Sept. 4.—J. M. Tollman, owner of Pine Ridge ranch near here, upset the theory that sleep is vital to acquiring weight when he shattered all records for fattening hogs at his ranch.

The hogs gained 86 poinds weight in 88 days, or fattened from an average weight of 117 pounds to 203 pounds. Tollman awakened the hogs every two hours and fed them a mixture of corn, barley and rye, he said.


