CANADA THIRD IN CONTEST FOR THE KOLAPORE CUP

South African Veterans Rifleman Win Famous Match at Bisley.

Bisley Camp, England, July 14.—(Canadian Associated Press)—The South African team today won the historic Kolapore Cup. The mother country was second and Canada third. The South African team established a lead at the first 300 yards and though the Canadians did the second range in the same number of shots, the South Africans increased their lead at the third range—600 yards—and finally won by fifteen points from the mother country team. The Canadian team did not shoot so well as the mother country at the last range. The South African team consisted entirely of veteran shots all of whom have been frequent visitors to Bisley. Its victory was, however, thoroughly well deserved. This is the first time South Africa has won the Kolapore Cup. The team scores at the third range—600 yards and totals were: South Africa 358, aggregate 1,111; Mother Country 354, aggregate 1,083; Canada 345, aggregate 1,066; India 336, aggregate 1,009; Guernsey 285, aggregate 998.

Individual Canadian scores and aggregates were: Richardson 46, 142; Utton 44, 141; Northover 46, 142; Crowe 42, 134; Vincent 38, 121; Nix 46, 136; Hawkins 38, 121; Edmond 44, 134.

Bisley Camp, July 14.—With twelve men already certain and one attached member to shoot off tonight, Canada has a creditable representation for the second stage of the King's prize. Last year eighteen Canadians entered the second stage but the team then was exactly double.

In the Duke of Cambridge prize, Lieut. John Chandler, Woodstock (N. B.), came eighth; Sergeant A. McCabe, Charlottetown, came twenty-first and Major Utton, thirty-two and 60.
