GERMAN HEADS FINN ARMY

General Von Der Goltz Now Supreme
in the Little Country

Moscow, May 30—(Associated Press)
—A German general is now supreme
command of the Finnish army, as well
as of the German forces in Finland.
General Mannerheim, who resigned last
month after leading the campaign of
the Finnish White Guard which result-
ed in the defeat of the Red Guard, has
been replaced by the German general
Von Der Goltz.

General Mannerheim resigned be-
cause, although he said he was willing
to free Finland from the Red Guard,
he would not support the German plan
for domination of Finland as it is ruling
Ukraine, and for the capture of Rus-
sian territory east of the Finnish border,
in the Mourmansk region.
