

MARINE NOTES.

THE POTATO EMBARGO


Washington, Jan. 1—Regulations of the most exacting character, regulating the importation of foreign potatoes into the United States, to guard against potato diseases, were laid down by Secretary Houston, of the department of agriculture today, in the form of official decision.
Forms requiring importers to notify the department of all shipments from countries not at present under the absolute quarantine ban, and the enforcement of a rigid inspection upon entry by the department's agents, are contained in the order.
The regulations also provide for lift-

ing, under certain conditions, the quarantine now enforced against most of the potato-growing sections of the world. Upon the presentation of satisfactory evidence to the secretary of agriculture that a country is free from injurious potato diseases and insect pests, potato will be admitted from that country accordance with the regulations governing the importations from countries now quarantined against.
