Report of Same Committee on the Representation of Christ Church, Listowel.

The Report was read as follows :

In the matter of Christ Church, Listowel, the regular meeting was called on April 26th, 1886, for the election of Lay Representatives to Synod, when the names of Messrs. R. Martin and A. J. Collins were moved and seconded as Lay Representatives. No vote was taken at that session, and the meeting adjourned to April 30th. At the said adjourned meeting the names of Messrs. Martin and Collins, as Lay Representatives, were introduced, and the names of Messrs. George Draper and George H. Richardson were also moved and seconded.
