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Q 12. Did you have any conversation with Lieut. C.W. Knox about this Ford vehicle No CM 4202187?

A 12. I asked him if he knew anything about it. He replied he knew nothing about it.

Q 13. Did you have any other conversation with Lieut. C.W. Knox?

A 13. No Sir.

Q 14. What can you say about the condition of Lieut Knox?

A 14. He was very slovenly dressed. His battle dress was undone and he had no hat.

Q 15. Was he drunk?

A 15. He was not drunk but he had been drinking.

Q 16. Is that all you know?

A 16. Yes Sir.
