Mc-dregor, 21st Regiment; W. C. Kenne-dy, E. N. Bartlett, Dr. H. A. Dewar, Windsor; Major H. Kemmis-Belty, Ottawa, 1st Contingent; Hon. Justice R. F. Sutherland and Albert B. Cam-eron, Toronto; Robt. Bray, Chatham; Joseph Marr, Winnipeg; Dr. Hoar, Wm. Robins, Walkerville, and many other Canadians as well as Americans whose sympathies are absolutely with the Allies. Why penalize these men because of Mr. Ford's views. As Cana. dian shareholders and as a Canadian company and in every other way our sympathies and resources are absolute-ly with the Allies.
