A Husband Shoots His Wife and then Kills Himself.

PHILADELPHIA, Sept. 24.

At an early hour this morning Thomas Brown, of No. 125 Kingsessing Avenue, Philadelphia, was found dead in his home, slain by his own hand. All the particulars known thus far are as follows:—Yesterday Mr. and Mrs. Parker, after dinner, stepped into their parlor in the door and went out for a ride, as was their custom of an afternoon. They were gone until about five o'clock, when they returned home, and an hour or so after took tea. They retired for the night at an early hour, and this was the last seen of them by the servants that night. Mr. Parker occupied the front room on the first floor, while Mrs. Parker slept in a chamber in the rear. A small crib near her bed being used by their three-year-old boy, the only child. The female servant, some three or four in number, occupied the rear room on the second floor. The rooming and remaining attached to the house was a coachman, who slept over the stable in the rear. From what could be learned it was a considerable time after they had retired that Mr. Parker, after entering a sharp four-barrelled revolver, stepped into his wife's room. His wife was sleeping the sleep of the thoughtless and innocent; the baby dreamed sweetly near by. The husband raised the fatal instrument, aimed and fired. These, without pausing for a moment to see the result of the shot, he placed the revolver to his ear and instantly fired his own life. When found the body was still in his hands, with two chambers empty and all the others charged. The ball fired at the wife penetrated her face directly under her left eye, entered the bones of the cheek and lodged there without piercing the brain. A scream from Mrs. Parker raised the servants and they found her and her husband in the condition described above, while the infant was undisturbed. Dr. Parker was immediately summoned and he examined the wound of the wife and at once made an examination of the wound of the body. He says he thinks it very probable that the husband was very bad one. Various rumors and surmises as to the motive of the crime are current, but nothing positive is known.
