Collectors, and the said Owners or Importers, the Opinion of two of which Merchants shall be final. Provided always, that it shall be lawful for the faid Collectors to keep the Custody of the Articles about which the Difference shall arise until the same shall be adjusted.

Collector to keep goods in cultody

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That all persons whatfoever, who shall have any Goods, Wares or Merchandise so to be imported as aforefaid, in his, her or their custody or possession, after the publication hereof, of the value of Fifty Pounds or upwards, without a certificate that the Duty of Excise has been secured thereon, such person or persons shall be subject to the penalty or penalties, and the Goods, Wares or Merchandise to the same forfeiture and distribution as is directed for the like offence, in, and by an Act passed in the twenty-fourth year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Att for more effectually railing a Duty of Excise on Wine, Rum and certain other enumerated articles, and for preventing frauds in the collection of the Revenue, and as also is directed in the several Alls afterwards made for the altering, continuing and amending the faid All, unless such person or persons shall have obtained a permit or certificate in the manner and form directed in, and by the faid Acts. And all masters of vessels, or owners neglecting to make report and entry of the Goods, Wares and Merchandise so imported in the manner and form directed in, and by the faid last before mentioned Act, and the several Acts for amending, altering and continuing thereof, or who shall break Bulk or remove any of the faid articles, before he or they shall have permission so to do, such owners or masters shall be subject to the several penalties, and the Goods, Wares or Merchandise to the several forfeitures, appointed and directed in and by the faid Act, and the faid feveral Acts in amendment thereof. And the owners or perfons removing any of the faid Goods, Wares or Merchandise without first obtaining a permit or permits in the manner directed in, and by the faid last last recited Acts, and all other person or persons whatfoever who shall in any shape whatfoever, by any manner of ways, or means, endeavour to evade the securing and payment of the said Duties, on the faid Goods, Wares or Merchandise so to be imported as aforesaid, or prevent or endeavor to prevent the faid Collectors from doing their duty in the execution of this Act, shall suffer and pay the same penalties and forfeitures directed and appointed for the like offences in, and by the faid last recited Acts, and all of the faid Goods, Wares, or Merchandife, which shall be clandestinely landed, removed, or in any shape whatsoever disposed of, contrary to the provisions made relative to Spirits and other articles in the said recited Acts, shall be subject to the seizure, condemnation and distribution, directed and appointed in, and by the faid last recited Acts, and all drawbacks of the Duties . of Excise herein and hereby imposed, shall be obtained and paid in the manner herein after directed and appointed.

If any be found with sol. worth of goods without a certificate, to be forfeited and di-Stributed as direlled by All of 24th of Geo. 3.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That all Trials for Forfeitures and Penalties on a Breach of this Act, shall commence and be feitures as by be-
