A report has been received from Mr. Abraham that the closets at the Nama Council House are in a bad state of repair. He recommends that larger and more up-to-date closets be erected and that the buildings for men and women be separated by some distance.

As many public gatherings are held at the Council House it is considered that Mr. Abraham's recommendation is in order, and I would ask you to lay the matter before the Council and have the matter dealt with at once and report to the Department.

It is advisable a resolution be passed approving of the erection of new buildings, and it would be well to furnish an estimate of the cost.
