

RCAF TRACK ATHLETES DEFEAT ARMY

Camp Borden's two sections—Air Force and Army—fought it out in a combined track and field meet, Tuesday, the RCAF winning by 56 points to 33.

Flying Officer Mark Burnett, RCAF, formerly of Windsor, made a new camp record of 11 feet 6 inches in the pole vault, while other prominent winners were LAC O. Bach, a Norwegian in the RCAF, who captured both the one mile and 440 yards, and Cpl. J. Richardson, No. 1 CACTR, who won the half mile. F/O Burnett also captured the broad jump at 20 feet 1½ inches.
