Dear Mr. Meighen:-

Shortly after you left for the South,
I received several code messages from Edmonton regarding a
desire on the part of certain Progressives to make an
arrangement with us, and on my way West, I stopped off at
Edmonton, and the following is an outline of the situation,
as I see it.

1. Members of the Provincial Government of Alberta,
and the Federal Progressive members from Alberta, are
working in close harmony.
2. There are certain things upon which all of them
are agreed, and if we could meet them, there is
strong possibility of securing their support.

In conversation with one of the Ministers,
he suggested certain measures, which I will now outline.

1. The desirability of one session at least.
2. An earnest and effective effort on the part of
the Dominion authorities to improve the system for
the marketing of farm products, having particularly
in mind the marketing of live stock.
3. The return of natural resources, the demand for
which has been greatly stimulated by your speech in
Edmonton, on the coal situation.
