Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 27th instant, inclosing a letter addressed you by Chief Alfred Crowe, in regard to purchase by him of Lot No. 8 on the Rice Lake Reserve, stated to belong to Mrs. Eliza Martin, and in reply to say that no location ticket has been issued to Mrs. Martin for this lot, and before the Department will consent to accept a transfer thereof, it will be necessary for the Band to locate her in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Act, so that location ticket may be issued. After the issue of location ticket, there would not appear to be any objection to the purchase of the lot by Chief Alfred Crowe, but the Department is not in a position to advance money, as desired.
