- Question 21            How do you know the time of your being disturbed on night 30-31 Aug?  
Answer                I looked at the clock and it was 0040 hrs.
- Question 22            Is there any possibility of the clock being wrong?  
Answer                No, sir.
- Question 23            What time did you reach the rd?  
Answer                At approx 0045 hrs.
- Question 24            What would you estimate the lapse of time between your noticing the soldiers and coming in contact with them?  
Answer                A matter of seconds or minutes.
- Question 25            How did you recognize the two accused?  
Answer                By their hair mainly, also their build.
- Question 26            Did you notice anything about their dress?  
Answer                I noticed they were wearing battledress undone at the neck.
- Question 27            You did not notice their dress lower down?  
Answer                No, sir.
- Question 28            Did you notice anyone with a DRS crash helmet?  
Answer                No, sir.
- Question 29            When you visited the quarry on morning 31 Aug with whom did you come?  
Answer                With Supt J Lewis, Monsouth. We were followed in a car by 3 civilians. I did not see what these civilians were doing.
- Question 30            You returned to the quarry on the evening of 31 Aug?  
Answer                Yes sir. I had a look around to try and identify the third man with whom I wanted to compare Gnr Gray. On comparison I was satisfied that my identification of Gnr Gray was correct.
- Question 31            Before you made enquiries on night 30/31 Aug did you know there were troops in the quarry?  
Answer                No Sir.
- Question 32            Has you been informed officially of presence of troops in the quarry or vicinity?  
Answer                No Sir.

Second witness            H24129 A/Sgt Brown; E J 2 Cdn CBO staff RGA  
for the prosecution        sworn, states:

Sir I left Camp (the gravel quarry) at approximately 2000 hrs in company with Gnr Pyfe and proceeded to the pub at Whitebrook where I spent the evening. I left the pub at closing time and with L/Bdr Stewart, Gnr Gray, Pte Dunard and Gnr Pyfe we started up the road together and as we walked we straggled apart and after sometime I found myself walking with Gnr Pyfe - the others having got seperated from us. After a distance of approximately 1/2 mile I missed Gnr Pyfe and proceeded back to camp where I was alone. During the walk back I heard footsteps behind me from time to time. I arrived back in camp at approximately 2300 hrs.
