Second witness for the prosecution

H24120 A/Sgt Brown; E J 2 Cdn CBo staff RCA sworn, states;

Sir I left Camp (the gravel quarry) at approximately 2000 hrs in company with Our Pyre and proceeded to the pub at Whitebrook where I spent the evening. I left the pub at closing time and with I/Bdr Stewart, Sur Gray, Pte Banard and Gur Pyre we started up the read together and as we walked we straggled apart and after sometime I found myself walking with Our Pyre - the others having got seperated from us. After a distance of approximately 2 mile I missed Our Pyre and proceeded back to camp where I was alone. During the walk back I heard footsteps behind me from time to time. I arrive back in camp at approximately 2500 hrs.
