

WINDSOR MILLS.


This village, beautifully situated on the north-eastern side of the St. Francis River, will likely be, in a near future, one of the largest manufacturing places in the townships. Kattopekah's river, which runs across the village, while already causing to move four large mills, still has many profitable water powers that may be made useful. Situated in the heart of a good farming country, it has four mills—paper mill, powder mill, grist mill and saw mill—four churches, Episcopal, Methodist, Presbyterian and Roman Catholic; five hotels, eleven stores, two blacksmith shops, two tinsmith shops, etc., one Town Hall, a Nunnery, good schools and a telephone office. Railway communications by Grand Trunk railway. Distance from Sherbrooke 15 miles and from Richmond 10 miles. Mails twice a day from Montreal and daily from Portland and Quebec. It has also a distributing office to the parish of St. Francois-Xavier de Brompton semi-weekly. Population 1200.
