Situated in the heart of a good farming country, it has four mills-paper mill, powder mill, grist mill and saw mill-four churches, Episcopal, Methodist, Presbyterian and Roman Catholic; five hotels, eleven stores, two blacksmith shops, two tinsmith shops, etc., one Town Hall, a Nunnery, good schools and a telephone office. Railway communications by Grand Trunk railway. Distance from Sherbrooke 15 miles and from Richmond 10 miles. Mails twice a day from Montreal and daily from Portland and Quebec. It has also a distributing office to the parish of St. Francois-Xavier de Brompton semi-weekly. Population 1200.
