JULY.—There have been frequent discussions as to the best method of having horses kept in good condition during the working season. It is said that there is no better medicine to keep working horses in good condition during summer than a bite of grass. Horses that have such slow work as ploughing are better out in the field at night, where they can get such grass as will keep them feeding half the time. They should, however, have their regular feed in the stable before being turned out, as the grass will not answer in the place of more substantial feed. Never let a work horse spend the Sunday nor holiday in the stable. Turn him out. The extra cleaning he may require by reason of rolling in the mud, will be all the better for him.
