erected into one distinct and seperate county, to be called and known by the name of King's County.

And whereas by like letters patent in like manner fince passed, garen's County. another tract or diffrict of land lying within this province, on both fides the river St. John, bounded on the fouth-east by King's county, on the fouth-west by Charlotte county, on the north-east by the county of Northumberland, and on the north-west by the fouth boundary line of Burton township, and by a continuation of the faid line to the north-east and south-west until it meets the counties of Northumberland and Charlotte respectively; was also erected into one distinct and seperate county to be called and known by the name of Queen's County.

And whereas by like letters patent, in like manner fince passed, ros. another tract or diffrict of land lying within this province on both sides the river St. John, bounded on the south-west by Charlotte county, on the north-east by the county of Northumberland, on the north-west by the province of Quebec, and on the south-east by the north-boundary line of the township of Magerville, and by the faid line continued to the north-east till it meets the western bounds of Northumberland county, and fouth-west to the eastern bounds of the county of Charlotte, was also erected into one distinct and seperate county to be called and known by the name of the County of York.

And whereas by like letters patent in like manner fince passed, 64 abort the county of Sunbury was limited and bounded on the north-west by the county of York, on the north-east by the county of Northumberland, on the fouth-east by Queen's county, and on the fouth-west by the County of Charlotte.

And whereas his Majesty did further grant and declare in the court houses faid letters patent respectively, that his loving subjects then residing and goals to be and who thereafter should inhabit within the faid counties res- lows, vir. pectively, might at their own charge erect a court-house and goal in each of the said counties, viz. at the city of St. John, Atthebity of St. in the county of St. John; at Westmorland, in the county of morland, at St. Westmorland; at St. Andrew's, in the county of Charlotte; at Kingson, King flon, in King's county; at Gagetown, in Queen's county; and a Gagetown, at Fredericton, in the county of York, which said several towns were thereby declared to be the county towns of the faid counties respectively.

And whereas the faid several lines limiting and bounding the Counties said respective counties cannot in the present condition of the pro- vided into towns or parameter. vince be furveyed and finally ascertained, notwithstanding which it is at present necessary that the said several counties be subdivided into towns or parishes for the more convenient and orderly distributions of the respective inhabitants, to enable them in their respective districts to fulfil the several duties incumbent on them, and
