James Cuthbert, Efquire, Member for the County of Warwick, who had previoufly taken the Oath, according to Law, before the Commisfioners, and fubscribed the Roll containing the same, took his feat in the House.

The order of the day, for the Houfe to refolve itself into a Committee of the whole Houfe, on the Bill for establishing regulations respecting Aliens, and certain Subjects of His Majesty who have resided in France, coming into this Province, or residing therein, being read;
