Inhabitats of the several Townships in this Province to maintain their Poor, with sever al Amendments, to which they defire the Concurrence of this Houfe.

The Council do agree to the Conference as defired by this House immediately in the Committee Room of the Council.

And then the Meffenger withdrew.

The House proceeded to take the Amendments made by the Council to the abovementioned Bill into Confideration, and the fame having been read throughont a first and second Time, were upon the Question severally put thereupon, agreed to by the House.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Council, and acquaint them the House have agreed to the Amendments made by them.

Ordered, That the Managers do attend at the Conference with the Council, and the Names of the Managers were called over, and they went to the Conference accordingly.

And being returned.

Mr. Tonge, reported, that the Managers had been at the Conference and flated the Substance of the faid Conference to the House.

A Meffage from the Council by Mr. Gautier. Mr. Speaker,

The Council have not agreed to the Refolve of this Houfe for granting the Sum of £199. for the Road leading from Onflow to Tatamagushe.

And then the Messenger withdrew.

On Motion refolved, that in the Opinion of this House, it is necessary, that in Addition to the Sum of  $\pounds_{5650}$  already Voted this Seffion, and agreed to by his Majerty's Council, the further Sum of  $\pounds_{4350}$ , should be granted to be expended in making and repairing Roads and Bridges throughout the Province. Provided, that no part of fuch further Sum shall be drawn out of the Treasury until the Inhabitants of the feveral Townships and Districts in which fuch Sum is to be expended fhall fatisfy the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being, and his Majesty's Council, that such Inhabitants have already expended a Sum equal to one third Part of the Sum appropriated to the making fuch Roads or Bridges, then it shall be lawful to appoint Commissioners to expend the Sum appropriated for fuch Roads or Bridges thereby to aid fuch Inhabitants, and encourage their future Exertions in completing the fame.

Refolved, That the faid Refolution be fent to his Majesty's Council, and that a Conference be defired with them on the subject Matter thereof.

Ordered, That the Clerk do defire the faid Conference. Ordered, That the Managers who managed the last Conference with his Majesty's Council do manage this Conference.

On Motion the House refolved, itself into a Committee of the whole House on the Government Estimate, and the Pecuniary Concerns of the Province.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair,

Mr. Belcher, took the Chair,

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair,

The Chairman reported from the Committee, that they had made further Progreis in the Business to them referred, and that the Committee had directed him to move for leave to fit again on the Confideration of the fame, which Report the House agreed to.

Then the House adjourned till To-morrow at Ten of the Clock.
