**Children Cry FOR FLETCHER'S CASTORIA**

Two killed in storm. By center Lisset wire. Monday, N.B., Aug. 15. Shilling Murray and Charles Jamieson were killed at Cherryfield. Three miles from Moncton, and a barn and three calves burned at Coverdale.
