WILL INTRODUCE ANOTHER LOAN BILL.

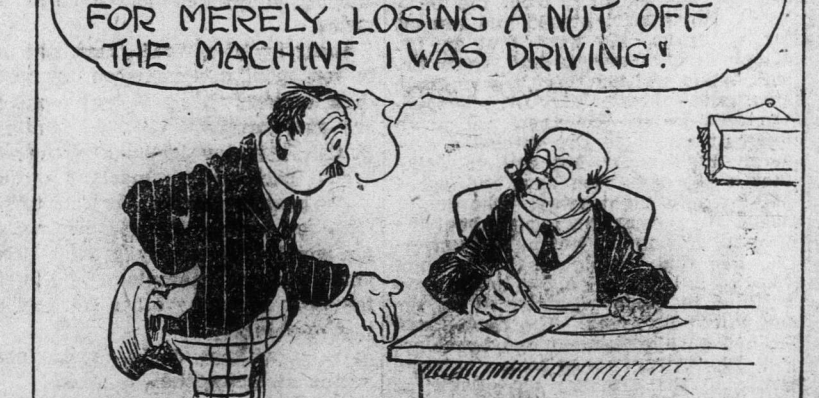

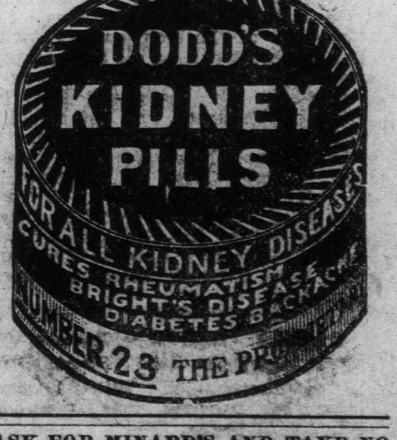
