Raid Paris, Oct. 22.—An official note israids of airships over France last week says: "Information obtained up

Two others fled, but were attacked by four aviators belonging to Escadrilles N-77, N-91 and N-89 (Nieuport chaser machines). The pilots were forced to cease their attack when their ammunition was exhausted.
