Some sensational developments are expected when the O. H. A. sub-committee meets in Toronto this evening. Several clubs and players will be investigated, and it is not unlikely the pro ranks will be swelled materially as a result. While the Toronto clubs are chiefly under investigation, a dispatch from the Queen City this morning states that the London and Sarnia intermediates will also be hauled onto the carpet. The charges against these two teams is that of importing players.

As far as the local club is concerned, no fear is expressed over the investigation. It is news to the London Hockey Club officials that charges have been made against the club, but it is not causing any worry. The London club has a couple of players who played in different towns last winter, but they came to London of their own accord, and it was not known they were in the city until just recently. Edwards and Hall are the players in question. Edwards has been here for some time, and he was not discovered until September until he began to practice with the football club. Hall came here shortly after the final game with Collingwood last March. He was representing the Armour Packing Company in Collingwood, but his firm closed up its business there and established an agency here. He was sent here. He lived at his old home, Woodstock, for a short time before moving here.

He represented the Armour people in London until just recently when he decided to open up a business of his own. He will open up one of the biggest pool parlors in the city shortly, and he is representing the local Canadian League player, will run it. When asked about the charges against London, Secretary Barney Vining stated this morning that he had heard nothing about them, but that the O. H.
