

Alarm Over Milk Supply

Seattle Medical Men Discover That Terrible Danger to Community Exists There.

Ailatation For Greater Cleanliness and Purity May Extend to Other Coast Cities.

Synopsis of the Regulations Which Now Apply in this City.

The following recommendations are made by the medical society:

1-That a committee be appointed by the King County Medical Society to investigate the conditions of the milk supply in Seattle.

2-That in the new ordinance shall be required licenses of all dairies, shops and houses from which milk is sold.

3-That to obtain such licenses the applicant must not only submit to inspection his premises, but also a written agreement from the farmer or milk seller from whom he obtains his milk that the farmer or milk seller will also agree to inspection by the agents of the city board of health.

4-That licenses and milk vendors should be compelled to report cases of infectious diseases among those who handle milk for sale.

5-That milk above 60 degrees Fahrenheit should be considered as unfit for use.

6-That the licenses of dairies, wagons and shops not complying with the requirements as to cleanliness, including such features as cement floors and screens over windows in dairies, should be suspended.

7-That bottling of milk be forbidden except at the farm or city dairy.

8-That the fact, including the temperature of the milk, and the process, by means of labels on the bottles or otherwise.

9-That milk tins be destroyed after they are returned from the consumer and not passed about from one person to another.

10-That a colonist reporter, yesterday afternoon visited the city hall and obtained a copy of the new ordinance.

"No milk that has been adulterated or the addition of water or other substance or by the removal of cream, nor milk known as milk, nor milk from cows or other animals fed upon distillery slop, starch factory products, manure, or other such filthy material, shall be offered for sale in the city of Victoria."

"All dairymen and vendors of milk and all drivers of milk wagons or vehicles having milk for sale at any place at the time shall furnish the medical health officer or sanitary inspector with such samples of milk as shall be demanded from him since the date of his last visit."

"Every sample of milk shall have a label attached to the vessel containing the milk, which shall have written thereon at the time of collecting the number of the sample, date of collection, and the initials of the inspector, who shall at once enter in a book carried for that purpose the name of the vendor, the corresponding number, with the name of the driver and driver from whom said sample was obtained, and shall also duplicate of such sample in a sealed bottle or container, the contents of which the sample was taken."

"Every sample shall be examined separately, according to the method of the medical health officer, who shall register the percentage of butter fat reported by a corresponding number in a book kept for that purpose, the name of the vendor to be subsequently in-
