god fays he must die." Then the operation went on till the unhappy youth expired. This is a fact, and thousands here of equal barbarity might be collected. Such, dear Sir, is the Hindoo religion in some of its fruits. It is full of malignity and all manner of abominations. The temples are filled with dancing girls, whole history you know from books. I cannot fpeak of their deteftable rites. The old filthy fystem of Paganism in Greece and Rome. is, in spirit, the fame as that now in being among the Hindoos, and perhaps is not lefs polluted, though it be fomewhat more retired. I am ashamed tofay, that my eyes have feen what I now ---; but unlefs I had feen it, my testimony would have been fcarcely credible, and I never could have fpoken. with fuch abhorrence as I now feel."

A report has lately prevailed, which, if it should prove true, would be a further inducement to attempt the converfion of the Hindoos, that in Hindostan there has lately arisen "a religion, which, its followers, in contradiction to the former uniform practice of the believers
