

BOOK AND TRACT COMMITTEE.

The regular Monthly Meeting of the Book and Tract Committee was held in the Board Room on Monday, the 12th August, 1867, at 3, P.M. Present—Rev. Canon Beaven, the Provost of Trinity College, Rev. Dr. O'Meara, Rev. A. Williams, and Rev. Canon Read.

An application was received from Rev. C. E. Thomson, of Elora, for a grant of Books and Tracts to the amount of \$10.—Granted.

Dr. Lett applied for a grant of Confirmation Tracts.—Granted \$2.30.

It was agreed to recommend that the Society authorize a grant to the Hospital, Gaol, House of Industry, and of single Books of Scripture in large type, Tracts specially addressed to Soldiers and Sailors and Tracts for the use of persons in Hospitals, and for prisoners.

Rev. Dr. O'Meara and Rev. Canon Read applied for grants of books for their respective Sunday Schools.* Ten dollars each were granted.
