RE BARLEY, DECEASED, AND FAWCETT, A LUNATIC—SUTHERLAND, J., IN CHAMBERS—DEC. 4.

Lunatic — Maintenance — Insufficient Material.]—Motion by the Inspector of Prisons and Public Charities, for an order for payment out of Court of certain moneys for maintenance. The learned Judge said that it was not made to appear upon the material that the amount in Court is or is not the original sum mentioned in paragraph 6 of the affidavit of the applicant, with accumulated interest. If it is, then I think no order can be made, in view of the terms of the trust referred to in said paragraph. If a consent were obtained from those entitled on the death of the lunatic, probably an order would be made. If the fund in Court is in part other moneys to which the lunatic is entitled, to that extent an order might now be made on that fact being shewn by further material. G. M.
